



RULES, REGULATIONS, STUDENT CONDUCT

FIRE 1

- Classes begin **PROMPTLY** at 18:30 Weekdays and 08:30 Weekends. Fireground training requires you to arrive early to ensure you have your equipment ready to begin class on time.
- Parking is located adjacent to the Hartford County Fire House across the street from the Academy Administration Building and Firefighter Memorial. Park only in the gravel parking lot. **NO STUDENT VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIRE TRAINING GROUNDS.**
- No Smoking in any Fire School Buildings or on the Training Grounds. No Alcohol or Drugs are permitted on Fire School Property.
- No Food is allowed in the classroom and all liquids must be in covered containers.
- All students are responsible to keep the Station and Fireground areas clean.
- Students are expected to come prepared for learning both mentally and physically. Proper rest, diet and hydration will result in improved performance and will reduce the chances of fatigue, illness or injury.
- Students are reminded that they are representing the fire service and their department. It is expected that appearance and personal conduct will reflect positively on both.
- Shorts and T-Shirts are permissible and encouraged in warm weather. Items should be clean and not torn and should not be excessively short or tight. Tank tops, halter tops, and sports bras are not acceptable as shirts. Open Toed Shoes, bare or stocking feet are not allowed on the fireground.
- For your safety – Ornamental jewelry will not be allowed on the fireground during training. This includes but is not limited to piercing jewelry. NFPA guidelines regarding facial hair are enforced at the Fire School.
